BILATERAL AGENCIES' BUSINESS PLANS FOR THE YEARS 2014-2016

#### Introduction

1. The following bilateral agencies submitted business plans for the years 2014-2016 to the 71<sup>st</sup> meeting: Germany, Italy and Japan<sup>1</sup>. The business plans of Italy and Japan were adjusted to include multi-year agreement (MYA) activities associated with HCFC phase-out management plans (HPMPs) that had been approved in principle. Although France did not officially submit a business plan for the years 2014-2016, the present document has included a table with allocation of resources for France based on MYA activities associated with HPMPs approved in principle. Bilateral agencies intend to have activities (excluding regional projects) in 18 Article 5 countries, namely: Afghanistan, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, China, Colombia, Ghana, India, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Kenya, Lao People's Democratic Republic (the), Lesotho, Liberia, Mauritius, Mexico, Papua New Guinea, Seychelles and Zimbabwe at a value of US \$13,294,723. An additional US \$2,838,400 would be requested for the period 2017 to after 2020 as shown in Table 1<sup>2</sup>.

#### **COMMENTS**

2. The Fund Secretariat reviewed each bilateral donor's business plan and provided comments on several of the proposed activities.

#### France

3. The resource allocation in France's 2014-2016 business plan is presented in Table 2. Twenty per cent of France's annual pledged contribution for 2014 amounts to US \$2,082,960.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Bilateral cooperation may be considered as a contribution to the Multilateral Fund up to a value of 20 per cent of a country's annual pledge to the Fund, consistent with any criteria specified by decisions of the Parties. The Executive Committee decided to allow flexibility in the year for which bilateral projects would be credited, provided that bilateral agencies submitted their work plans at the beginning of the year in time for the Secretariat to transmit them to the Executive Committee for consideration during discussions of the business plans at the Committee's first meeting of the year (decision 25/13(a)). It should be noted that traditional bilateral donors, such as Australia, Canada, the Czech Republic, Finland, France, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the United States of America did not submit bilateral business plans and the total value of bilateral activities could increase in the event of such submissions.

# Germany

4. The resource allocation in Germany's 2014-2016 business plan is presented in Table 3. Twenty per cent of Germany's annual pledged contribution for 2014 amounts to US \$2,727,612. If the remaining activities in Germany's 2013 business plan and those planned in its 2014 business plan were approved as planned, Germany will exceed the bilateral allocation for the 2012-2014 triennium by US \$289,657. Therefore, Germany would either re-programme activities for future years or request other bilateral or implementing agencies to implement the projects that exceed its 20 per cent allocation.

### Secretariat's comments

- 5. The Secretariat proposed adjustments to the approved MYAs' amount in Germany's business plans by increasing the budget by US \$1.7 million, based on the records of the Secretariat.
- 6. Germany's business plan includes US \$1.5 million for stage II HPMP for three low-volume-consuming (LVC) countries for which total phase-out projects have been approved for the year 2025 (Namibia and Papua New Guinea) and 2030 (Mauritius). The Secretariat proposed adjustments to reduce the budget accordingly.
- 7. Germany has proposed amounts that exceed by US \$42,795 the maximum level allowed for project preparation for stage II HPMPs pursuant to decisions 55/13 and 56/16. The Secretariat proposed adjustments to reduce the level of funding accordingly.
- 8. Table 4 presents the results of the Secretariat's proposed adjustments to Germany's business plan.

## Secretariat's comments

- 10. Italy has proposed amounts that exceed by US \$9,010 the maximum level allowed for project preparation for stage II HPMP projects pursuant to decisions 55/13 and 56/16. The Secretariat proposed adjustments to reduce the level of funding accordingly.
- 11. The Secretariat proposed adjusting the value of projects in the foam sector to a cost-effectiveness value of US \$6.92/kg<sup>3</sup>. Table 6 presents the results of the Secretariat's proposed adjustments to Italy's business plan.
