Los documentos previos al período de sesiones del Comité Ejecutivo del Fondo Multilateral para la Aplicación del Protocolo de Montreal no van en perjuicio de cualquier decisión que el Comité Ejecutivo pudiera adoptar después de la emisión de los mismos.

3. Los proyectos para la preparación de la etapa II o III de los PGEH, los KIP, y/o las actividades relacionadas con la inversión, los proyectos piloto para la eficiencia energética y el inventario nacional del banco de residuos de sustancias controladas y la elaboración de un plan, así como la renovación de proyectos de fortalecimiento institucional se presentan en la cooperación bilateral<sup>2</sup>, las enmiendas al programa de trabajo para 2023 del PNUD<sup>3</sup>, el PNUMA<sup>4</sup>, la ONUDI<sup>5</sup> y el Banco Mundial<sup>6</sup>.
