3. Les projets de préparation de la phase II ou III des PGEH, des KIP et/ou des activités liées aux investissements, des projets pilotes pour l'efficacité énergétique, relatifs à l'inventaire national des banques de déchets de substances contrôlées et l'élaboration d'un plan et les projets de renouvellement du renforcement institutionnel sont présentés dans les documents traitant de la coopération bilatérale² ainsi que ceux traitant des modifications du programme de travail 2023 du PNUD,³ PNUE,⁴ de l'ONUDI⁵ et de la Banque mondiale.⁶ Les tranches des PGEH approuvés pour 18 pays, répertoriées dans le tableau 2, sont présentées dans les propositions de projets des pays concernés, tout comme les 16 propositions de projets sur des activités supplémentaires visant à maintenir l'efficacité énergétique dans le secteur de l'entretien soumises conformément à la décision 89/6.
