# REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

## Introduction

1. This document presents a summary of financial adjustments indicated by the implementing agencies (IAs) and bilateral agencies (BAs) as agreed by the Secretariat. It includes statistical data<sup>2</sup> from all projects with balances that have been held for over 12 months following completion of the project, as required by decisions 28/7 and 56/2(c). It addresses balances to be returned against projects as a follow-up to relevant decisions (referred to as "by-decision" projects in this document). It also indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash as recorded in the status of contributions and disbursements document,<sup>3</sup> as required by decision 41/92(b), and presents a recommendation. The amounts that are held by IAs for completed projects, by-decisions and for additional voluntary contributions projects are included in annex I, annex II and annex III. Annex IV presents the funds returned by IAs from completed, by-decision and additional voluntary contributions projects.

# Funds to be returned to the 94th meeting

2. The total funds to be returned by IAs amount to US \$1,362,594 from completed, by-decisions, and additional voluntary contributions projects as shown in table 1.

## **Availability of resources**

4. The status of contributions and disbursements document indicates an available balance of US \$541,327,510 as of 25 April 2024. The total balance returned by IAs, to the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting amounts to US \$1,362,594. Therefore, the total level of resources available for approvals at the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting, is US \$542,690,104.

# **Secretariat's comments**

- 5. The Secretariat reminded IAs that balances of projects completed one year ago and more, by-decisions and additional voluntary contributions projects should be returned to the Multilateral Fund as soon as possible.
- 6. Considering that the total level of funding for projects and activities as submitted to the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting as of 1 April 2024 is US \$67,918,167 there are sufficient resources available for approvals at the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting.

#### Recommendation

- 7. The Executive Committee may wish:
  - (a) To note:
    - (i) The report on balances and availability of resources contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/94/4;
    - (ii) That the net level of funds being returned by the implementing agencies at the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting is US \$1,362,594 consisting of US \$239,606 plus agency support costs of US \$17,619 from UNDP; US \$469,599, plus agency support costs of US \$44,402 from UNEP; and US \$551,985, plus agency support costs of US \$39,383 from UNIDO;
    - (iii) That UNDP held balances of US \$71,695, including agency support costs, for seven projects completed over two years previously;
    - (iv) That UNIDO held balances of US \$72,926, including agency support costs, for five projects completed over two years previously, US \$823,615, including agency support costs, for three projects completed "by decision of the Executive Committee" and US \$116,758 including agency support costs, for four completed projects funded using the additional voluntary contributions made by a group of donor countries to finance fast-start activities for the implementation of HFC phase-down;
  - (b) To request UNDP and UNIDO:
    - (i) To proceed with disbursement or to cancel committed and not-committed funds that were not needed for completed projects, and to return the associated balances at the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting;
    - (ii) To proceed with disbursement or to cancel commitments for the projects completed over two years previously, and to return balances at the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting; and
  - (c) To further request UNIDO to proceed with disbursement or return at the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting the balances of the projects completed "by-decisions of the Executive Committee" and the completed projects funded using the additional voluntary contributions.
