3. The requests for the preparation of: stage II or III of HCFC phase-out management plans (HPMPs), Kigali HFC implementation plans (KIPs) and/or investment-related activities, pilot projects on energy efficiency in line with decision 91/65, and national inventories of banks of waste controlled substances in line with decision 91/66, as well as requests for the renewal of institutional strengthening (IS) projects, are presented in the 2024 work programmes of UNDP,² UNEP³ and UNIDO⁴ and in the document on bilateral cooperation.⁵ The requests for tranches of approved HPMPs for 12 countries (listed in table 2 below), tranche of an approved HFC-23 emissions control plan in Mexico, and for additional activities to maintain energy efficiency in the servicing sector in line with decision 89/6 in Belize, Cambodia, Cuba, Eswatini, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Paraguay, Saint Lucia, Sri Lanka, Timor-Leste and Zambia, are presented in the respective country project proposals.
