**Addendum**

**PROJECT PROPOSALS: EGYPT**

This addendum is issued to:

- **Add** the following paragraphs:

18 bis. The Secretariat and UNIDO have agreed on the total project cost at US \$5,602,000 for the complete phase out of MB used as a soil fumigant (377.7 ODP tonnes). Of this amount, US \$592,000 (equivalent to a phase out of 40 ODP tonnes of MB) will be provided by the Government of Egypt. Therefore, the total amount to be funded from the Multilateral Fund is US \$5,010,000. Of this amount, US \$2,750,592 would be required for the phase out of 185.6 ODP tonnes representing the amount of MB needed to achieve the 20 reduction in the MB baseline consumption by 2005.

18 ter. The Government of Egypt is committed to:

- (a) Permanently sustain the reduction in the consumption of MB through the implementation of the project proposal and achieve the 20 per cent reduction in the baseline consumption by 2005;
- (b) Completely phase out MB consumption by 2009 provided that the total project cost (US \$5,010,000) is approved; and
- (c) Sustain this phase-out of MB through import restrictions and controlled use of MB for all non-exempt MB uses.

- **Replace** paragraph 19 **with** the following:

19. The Executive Committee may wish to consider the project proposal on the basis of the comments presented in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/38/32 and Add.1.
