Se expide este documento para:

- **Sustituir**, el 2do círculo del Resumen ejecutivo de la manera siguiente :
 - los datos de 2008 notificados por ocho países sugieren el posible incumplimiento de las medidas de control de los CFC (Arabia Saudita, Bangladesh, Bosnia y Herzegovina, Estados Federados de Micronesia, Iraq, República Bolivariana de Venezuela, República Dominicana¹ y Vanuatu ; halones (Iraq y Vanuatu); metilbromuro (Iraq y Vanuatu); y medidas de control de CTC (Bolivia, Ecuador, Indonesia, Iraq, México y Turkmenistán).
- Para Argentina, los datos de 2008 sobre el consumo de CFC, **sustituir** 902,3 toneladas PAO **por** 50,8 toneladas PAO; y para el metilbromuro **sustituir** 221,1 toneladas PAO **por** 22,5 toneladas PAO mediante el documento UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/58/6.
