Addendum**PROJECT PROPOSALS: PAKISTAN**

The Secretariat concluded its discussions with the World Bank on issues raised in the Secretariat's comments on two commercial and one domestic refrigeration projects. Subsequently, the following adjustments have been made in project budgets reflecting existing guidelines and industry norms:

- costs of replacement and retrofitting of vacuum pumps were reduced in the three projects;
- cost of replacement of batch premixers based on occupational health considerations in Dawlance and United Refrigeration projects was reduced from US \$60,000 to US \$15,000.

The Secretariat, therefore, recommends the projects for blanket approval as follows:
