LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

I have the honour to transmit to you the Ghana Country Programme for the Phase-Out of Ozone Depleting Substances for consideration by the Eighth Meeting of the Executive Committee.

2. The Country Programme provides the strategies, action plan and project proposals by means of which the Government of Ghana will phase-out the ozone depleting substances faster than allowed under the amended Montreal Protocol.

3. In order to accelerate action in Ghana, project proposals have been prepared as an annex to the Country Programme. The Executive Committee is, therefore, being requested to approve funds amounting to US\$573,000 for immediate implementation of the projects. The sectors concerned are:

Institutional Strengthening	US\$160,000
Refrigeration	US\$328,000
Foams	US\$ 85,000

4. This request takes into consideration US\$99,000 available within UNDP 1991 Work Programme for Ghana for demonstration in improved servicing and maintenance in the refrigeration sector. That project has been revised in line with current needs of the country and the funds available will be used to start the programme, estimated at US\$427,000.

5. The Executive Committee is also requested to consider the request for the amount of US\$480,000 to establish a CFC-12 security stock (Project R-1.4).

6. Following the fax message (copy attached) received from UNDP, I wish to inform you that Ghana, particularly as Representative for the African Region, is most willing to avail its demonstration and training facility to other African countries. The Government is, therefore, willing to let the training programme serve as a core for the regional training programme envisaged. This, however, entails some revision in the estimated costs, which can be discussed with UNDP upon approval by the Executive Committee of the Ghana Country Programme. We hope, however, that this is not going to cause further delays in the implementation of the programme.

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7. Finally, I wish to reiterate Ghana's commitment to the objectives of the amended Montreal Protocol as manifested by her active participation in the activities under the Protocol.
