REPORT ON HOST COUNTRY AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE UNITED NATIONS ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME
("UNEP")

AND THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

1. At its 3rd meeting, the representative of UNEP reported "that consultation with the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations on Headquarters agreement between the United Nations and the Government of Canada had been concluded and that a draft text was ready for detailed discussion with the Canadian Authorities".
2. The Secretariat has further learnt that two draft agreements have been submitted to the Government of Canada.
3. The first draft agreement refers to that "BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA CONCERNING THE PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES, AND OTHER FACILITIES OF UNITED NATIONS OFFICIALS SERVICING THE SECRETARIAT OF THE MULTILATERAL FUND UNDER THE 1987 MONTREAL PROTOCOL ON SUBSTANCES THAT DEplete THE OZONE LAYER".
4. The second draft concerns "ANOTHER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATES PARTIES TO THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT IN CANADA OF THE SECRETARIAT OF THE MULTILATERAL FUND".
5. Both the draft agreements are presently under perusal by the Ministry of External Affairs, as per a verbal communication from Environment Canada to the Secretariat.
