SECRETARIAT'S COMMENTS

1. The project provides funds for the phase-out of the use of CFC-11 in the last of five flexible foam producing companies. The company will phase out the use of CFC-11 as blowing agent by substituting with methylene chloride. The cost of the project (US \$66,000) is mainly due to upgrading of ventilation and other safety measures and acquisition of methylene chloride metering pump.
2. The project will phase-out 20 tonnes of CFC-11. Its cost-effectiveness value of US \$3.40 per kg. per year is well below the threshold value (US \$6.23 per kg. per year) for the sector.

SECRETARIAT'S RECOMMENDATION

3. The Secretariat recommends approval of the project and the project incremental costs of US \$66,000.
