

OVERVIEW
UNIDO WORK PROGRAMME AMENDMENTS
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UNIDO has submitted a request for seven supplemental activities costing below US \$500,000 as amendments to its 1993 Work Programme for the total amount of US \$901,886.

US \$184,000 represents the costs of three activities in India for preparing the feasibility study for recovery and recycling in the refrigeration sector covering small enterprises in refrigeration, solvent and foam sectors.

US \$115,500 is requested for organization of a national awareness workshop in the refrigeration sector (US \$25,000) and preparation of investment projects in the refrigeration sector in Jordan (US \$90,000). Preparation of investment projects in the refrigeration sector provides the framework for dissemination of necessary information among major refrigeration companies and main refrigerator repair and maintenance centres, therefore, the Secretariat does not recommend approval of US \$25,000 for organization of a workshop. US \$90,000 are recommended for approval. It should be noted that the Government of Jordan and the World Bank are just about to sign a grant agreement for US \$1.5 million which covers several projects in the refrigeration sector, among others.

Two institutional strengthening projects for Egypt (US \$263,450) and Syria (US \$235,180) are recommended for approval.

The total amount recommended for approval is US \$873,071 including 13% support costs.
