PROJECT PROPOSAL SENEGAL

Project Title:

Continuation of the training of refrigeration technicians in good servicing techniques

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. This project will provide training to refrigeration servicing technicians in Senegal. Three training sessions will be organized in three different regions of the country. The project will also enable the introduction of good servicing techniques in training centers, the implementation of regulations concerning good servicing practices in the refrigeration sector, and the implementation of a monitoring system to establish statistics on the consumption of CFCs at the servicing level.

SECRETARIAT'S COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

COMMENTS

1. The project will be completed in six months after approval. The Executive Committee approved a request from UNEP for a training project for refrigeration technicians at its Eleventh Meeting in the amount of US \$58,000. The project was approved as submitted in the country programme of Senegal. The project was originally intended to train 200 service technicians in good servicing techniques in the country, but only 127 technicians could be trained with the budget provided for the project.

2. Subsequently, the Government of Senegal requested the Government of France to complete the training project. This project will train the remaining domestic refrigeration service technicians in Senegal and complete the implementation of the other objectives of the original approval. The project will be completed six months after its approval.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The proposal meets the guidelines of the Executive Committee and is recommended for approval in the amount requested, US \$16,500.

2. The Treasurer should offset US \$16,500 against the Government of France's 1996 contributions to the Fund.
